13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **(A)** The Secretary shall develop a statewide information technology master 18 plan.

19(B) THE STATEWIDE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY MASTER PLAN20DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE A21POLICY THAT:

22(1) REQUIRES A VENDOR SELLING AN INFORMATION23TECHNOLOGY PRODUCT OR PIECE OF EQUIPMENT TO A UNIT OF STATE



1 GOVERNMENT TO ESTABLISH THAT THE PRODUCT OR PIECE OF EQUIPMENT IS 2 SAFE FROM EMBEDDED SECURITY THREATS; AND

3 (2) SETS OUT THE STEPS THAT MUST BE TAKEN TO ESTABLISH 4 THAT THE PRODUCT OR PIECE OF EQUIPMENT IS SAFE FROM EMBEDDED 5 SECURITY THREATS.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2013.
