FOR the purpose of requiring the Social Services Administration of the Maryland 3 4 Department of Human Resources to request a security freeze on the consumer report or a certain record of certain protected consumers who are minor children $\mathbf{5}$ 6 in the custody of a local department of social services who have been placed in a 7 foster care setting in accordance with certain application procedures; requiring 8 a consumer reporting agency to place a security freeze for a protected consumer 9 under certain circumstances and within a certain period of time; requiring a 10 consumer reporting agency to create a certain record under certain 11 circumstances; requiring a local department of social services to act as a
