13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 (b) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, every new application for a 18 license shall be made to the Board of License Commissioners on forms prescribed by 19 the Comptroller and sworn to by the applicant. Every application for a license shall 20 contain the following:

(4) (i) Except as provided in subparagraphs [(ii) and (iv)] (III) AND
(V) of this paragraph, a statement that the applicant has been for two years next
preceding the filing of the application a resident of the county or of the City of
Baltimore in which the applicant proposes to operate under the license applied for.
