## Crimes – Trafficking of Human Organs – Penalties

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from recruiting, transporting, transferring,
  harboring, or receiving an individual, either living or deceased, for the purpose
  of removing one or more of the individual's organs by certain means; prohibiting
  a person from transporting or transplanting an organ obtained in a certain
  manner to one or more other persons under certain circumstances; providing
  penalties for a violation of this Act; defining a certain term; and generally
  relating to organ trafficking.
