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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Labor and Employment – Division of Labor and Industry – Appropriations**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor, beginning in a certain fiscal year, to  
4 include in the annual budget bill submitted to the General Assembly an  
5 appropriation for the Division of Labor and Industry of certain minimum  
6 amounts to fund at least a certain number of positions for implementation of the  
7 Employment Standards Service Unit and the Prevailing Wage Unit; and  
8 generally relating to the Division of Labor and Industry and funding for the  
9 Employment Standards Service Unit and the Prevailing Wage Unit.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
11 Article – Labor and Employment  
12 Section 2–107(g)  
13 Annotated Code of Maryland  
14 (2008 Replacement Volume and 2012 Supplement)

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Labor and Employment**

18 2–107.

19 (g) Notwithstanding the funding provisions of § 3–919 of this article, for  
20 fiscal year [2007] **2015** and for each subsequent fiscal year, the Governor shall include  
21 in the annual budget bill submitted to the General Assembly an appropriation for the  
22 Division of Labor and Industry sufficient to implement the provisions of this section,  
23 including amounts not less than:

1                   (1)     **[\$315,000] \$750,000 TO FUND AT LEAST 10 POSITIONS** for  
2 implementation of the Employment Standards Service Unit in the Division; and

3                   (2)     **[\$385,000] \$1,000,000 TO FUND AT LEAST 15 POSITIONS** for  
4 implementation of the Prevailing Wage Unit in the Division.

5                   SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
6 July 1, 2013.
