HOUSE BILL 1320

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Chapter 601 of the Acts of 2005, as amended by Chapter 420 of the Acts of 2009

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED. That the Governor shall $\mathbf{5}$ include a general fund appropriation of \$250,000 for the Department of Juvenile 6 7Services in each budget bill for fiscal 2007, fiscal 2008, fiscal 2009, fiscal 2010, fiscal 2011, fiscal 2012, and fiscal 2013 AND A GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION OF 8 \$300,000 FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE SERVICES IN EACH BUDGET 9 BILL FOR FISCAL 2015, FISCAL 2016, AND FISCAL 2017 for the purpose of 10 implementing the provisions of this Act. Of the [\$250,000] \$300,000 [\$83,000] 11 \$100,000 shall be provided as a grant to Baltimore County and [\$167,000] \$200,000 12shall be provided as a grant to Baltimore City for the purpose of implementing the 13provisions of this Act. 14SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED. That Section 1 of this Act shall 15

16 take effect July 1, 2006.

17 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, except as provided in 18 Section 4 of this Act, this Act shall take effect October 1, 2005. It shall remain effective 19 until the end of [June 30, 2013] JUNE 30, 2016, and, at the end of [June 30, 2013] 20 JUNE 30, 2016, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act 21 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23 June 1, 2013.
