### Public Senior Higher Education Institutions – Mandatory Fees – Limit on Increases

  may be charged each academic year to resident undergraduate and graduate
  students at public senior higher education institutions in the State; defining
  certain terms; and generally relating to limiting annual increases in mandatory
  fees at public senior higher education institutions.

### 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### 18 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 19 MEANINGS INDICATED.

20 (2) "ACADEMIC YEAR" MEANS THE PERIOD COMMENCING WITH 21 THE FALL SEMESTER AND CONTINUING THROUGH THE IMMEDIATELY 22 FOLLOWING SUMMER SESSION AT A PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION 23 INSTITUTION.
