Alcoholic Beverages - Vaportinis and Similar Devices - Prohibited

- FOR the purpose of expanding the definition of "AWOL machine" to include a Vaportini or any similar device, so as to prohibit a Vaportini or any similar device from being used to inhale alcohol vapor or otherwise introduce alcohol in any form into the human body; and generally relating to devices that may be used to inhale alcohol vapor or otherwise introduce alcohol into the human body.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- 18 (a) In this section, "AWOL machine" means an Alcohol Without Liquid device, A VAPORTINI, OR ANY SIMILAR DEVICE that mixes an alcoholic product with
- 20 pure oxygen or other gas to produce a vaporized product that can be inhaled.
- 21 (b) A person may not:
- 22 (1) Use an AWOL machine to inhale alcohol vapor or otherwise
- 23 introduce alcohol in any form into the human body; or

- 1 (2) With the intent to introduce alcohol into the human body, possess, 2 purchase, transfer, or offer for sale or use an AWOL machine.

 3 (c) (1) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$1,000.
- 5 (2) Each violation of this section is a separate offense.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 July 1, 2013.
