## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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## Public Schools – Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and Automated External Defibrillator Instruction – Graduation Requirement

FOR the purpose of requiring a public school student to complete instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an automated external defibrillator to graduate from high school beginning with students entering a certain grade in a certain year; requiring each county board of education to provide instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an automated external defibrillator in certain schools beginning in a certain year and using a certain instructional program and incorporating certain skills; requiring, if the instruction is offered for certification, a certain individual to conduct the instruction; authorizing, if the instruction is not offered for certification, a certain individual to facilitate, provide, or oversee the instruction; requiring the State Department of Education to develop a process to monitor the implementation of certain provisions of law; authorizing the State Superintendent of Schools, with the approval of the State Board of Education, to request that the State Comptroller withhold certain funds if a local school system fails to comply with certain requirements; requiring the Comptroller to withhold certain funds until receiving a certain notice; defining certain terms; and generally relating to instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an automated external defibrillator and high school graduation requirements in the State.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 3 **Article – Education** 7-205.1. 4 5 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 6 MEANINGS INDICATED. 7 "AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR" HAS THE MEANING 8 STATED IN § 13–517 OF THIS ARTICLE. 9 "PSYCHOMOTOR SKILLS" MEANS THE USE OF HANDS-ON 10 PRACTICING TO SUPPORT COGNITIVE LEARNING. 11 BEGINNING WITH STUDENTS ENTERING GRADE 9 IN THE 2013–2014 12SCHOOL YEAR, TO GRADUATE FROM A PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL, A STUDENT SHALL 13 COMPLETE INSTRUCTION IN CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION AND THE USE 14 OF AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR. 15 BEGINNING IN THE 2014–2015 SCHOOL YEAR, EACH COUNTY BOARD 16 SHALL PROVIDE INSTRUCTION IN CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION AND THE 17 USE OF AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR IN EVERY PUBLIC SCHOOL 18 THAT ENROLLS STUDENTS IN ANY OF THE GRADES 7 THROUGH 12 IN THE 19 COUNTY. 20 THE INSTRUCTION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTIONS (B) AND (C) OF 21THIS SECTION SHALL: 22**(1)** USE AN INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM THAT IS: 23 DEVELOPED BY THE AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION (I)24OR THE AMERICAN RED CROSS; OR 25 APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT AND THE COUNTY (II)26BOARD AND IS NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED AND BASED ON THE MOST CURRENT NATIONAL EVIDENCE-BASED EMERGENCY CARDIOVASCULAR CARE GUIDELINES 2728FOR CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION AND THE USE OF AN AUTOMATED 29 EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR; AND

30 (2) INCORPORATE THE PSYCHOMOTOR SKILLS NECESSARY TO 31 PERFORM CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION AND THE USE OF AN 32 AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR.

- IF THE INSTRUCTION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTIONS (B) 1 **(E) (1)** 2 AND (C) OF THIS SECTION IS OFFERED FOR CERTIFICATION, THE COURSE MUST 3 BE CONDUCTED BY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS CERTIFIED BY THE AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION, THE AMERICAN RED CROSS, OR A SIMILAR NATIONALLY 4 5 **INSTRUCTOR** RECOGNIZED **ENTITY** ASANOF **CARDIOPULMONARY** 6 RESUSCITATION AND THE USE OF AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR.
- 7 (2) IF THE INSTRUCTION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTIONS (B)
  8 AND (C) OF THIS SECTION IS NOT OFFERED FOR CERTIFICATION, A LICENSED
  9 TEACHER WHO IS NOT A CERTIFIED INSTRUCTOR OF CARDIOPULMONARY
  10 RESUSCITATION AND THE USE OF AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR
  11 MAY FACILITATE, PROVIDE, OR OVERSEE THE INSTRUCTION.
- 12 **(F)** THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP A PROCESS TO MONITOR THE 13 IMPLEMENTATION OF THE REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 14 (G) (1) IF A COUNTY BOARD FAILS TO COMPLY WITH THE
  15 REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION, THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT, WITH THE
  16 APPROVAL OF THE STATE BOARD, MAY REQUEST THE COMPTROLLER TO
  17 WITHHOLD UP TO 5% OF THE NEXT INSTALLMENT AND EACH SUBSEQUENT
  18 INSTALLMENT DUE THE COUNTY BOARD FROM THE GENERAL STATE SCHOOL
  19 FUND.
- 20 (2) (I) IF THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT MAKES A REQUEST
  21 UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE COMPTROLLER SHALL
  22 WITHHOLD THE REQUESTED PERCENT OF THE NEXT INSTALLMENT AND EACH
  23 SUBSEQUENT INSTALLMENT DUE THE COUNTY BOARD FROM THE GENERAL
  24 STATE SCHOOL FUND.
- 25 (II) IF THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT FINDS THAT THE
  26 COUNTY BOARD IS IN FULL COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS
  27 SECTION, THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL NOTIFY THE COMPTROLLER
  28 AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL RESUME DISTRIBUTION OF THE FULL AMOUNT
  29 OF THE NEXT INSTALLMENT AND EACH SUBSEQUENT INSTALLMENT DUE THE
  30 COUNTY BOARD.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
