A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Task Force to Study Mental Illness Among Students in Public Schools

- FOR the purpose of establishing the Task Force to Study Mental Illness Among Students in Public Schools; providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the Task Force; prohibiting a member of the Task Force from receiving certain compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the Task Force to study and make recommendations regarding certain matters; requiring the Task Force to report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and certain committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Task Force to Study Mental Illness Among Students in Public Schools.
- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That:
- 14 (a) There is a Task Force to Study Mental Illness Among Students in Public 15 Schools.
- 16 (b) The Task Force consists of the following eleven members:
- 17 (1) two members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the 18 President of the Senate;
- 19 (2) two members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker 20 of the House;
- 21 (3) the State Superintendent of Education, or the Superintendant's 22 designee;
- 23 (4) the Director of the Mental Hygiene Administration, or the 24 Director's designee; and

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2013. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of May 31, 2014, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
