Building Safety - Gas Piping Systems - Bonding Requirements

FOR the purpose of requiring a person installing yellow corrugated stainless steel tubing as part of a gas piping system to bond the system to a certain electrode system at a certain location; prohibiting a person from using a bonding wire that is smaller than a certain size when bonding a certain gas piping system in accordance with this Act; establishing a certain penalty for a violation of this Act; and generally relating to gas piping systems.

- 1 ELECTRODE SYSTEM MAY NOT USE A BONDING WIRE THAT IS SMALLER THAN A 6 2 AMERICAN WIRE GAUGE (AWG) COPPER WIRE OR THE EQUIVALENT.
- 3 (B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
 4 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT
 5 EXCEEDING 10 DAYS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2013.
