A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2003 – Anne Arundel County –**
3 **Annapolis Recreational Center at 9 St. Mary’s Street**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2003
5 to alter the purpose of a certain grant; extending the deadline for a certain
6 grantee to present evidence of a certain matching fund; extending the deadline
7 for certain funds to be expended or encumbered; making a technical correction;
8 and generally relating to amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond
9 Loan of 2003.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
11 Chapter 204 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2003, as amended by
12 Chapter 432 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2004 and Chapter 396
13 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2011
14 Section 13(3)(i) Item (A)

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Chapter 204 of the Acts of 2003, as amended by Chapter 432 of the Acts of**
18 **2004 and Chapter 396 of the Acts of 2011**

19 SECTION 13. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

20 (3) (i) \$15,200,000 for the following projects initially approved by the
21 Senate:

22 (A) [Annapolis Recreational Center at 9 St. Mary’s Street]
23 ANNAPOLIS CITY HALL. Provide a grant equal to the lesser
24 of (i) \$250,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund

1 provided, to the Mayor and City Council of **THE CITY OF**
 2 Annapolis for the planning, design, repair, renovation,
 3 reconstruction, and capital equipping of the [Annapolis
 4 Recreational Center at 9 St. Mary’s Street] **ANNAPOLIS CITY**
 5 **HALL**, located in Annapolis. Notwithstanding section 13(5) of
 6 this Act, the matching fund may consist of real property, in
 7 kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective
 8 date of this Act and the grantee must present evidence that a
 9 matching fund will be provided by June 1, [2013] **2014**.
 10 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the proceeds of
 11 the loan must be encumbered by the Board of Public Works or
 12 expended for the purposes provided in this Act no later than
 13 June 1, [2013] **2014** (Anne Arundel County) 250,000

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 15 June 1, 2013.
