13 14 15	WHEREAS, State law authorizes the BMC to serve, with the Maryland Department of Transportation, as a metropolitan planning organization for federal funding and certification; and						
16 17	WHEREAS, The BMC created the Baltimore Region Transportation Board in the BMC bylaws to serve as the designated metropolitan planning organization; and
