BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article – Natural Resources Section 3–302(a)(1) and 8–1913(a) and (c) Annotated Code of Maryland (2012 Replacement Volume) BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Natural Resources Section 3–302(d) and 8–1921 Annotated Code of Maryland (2012 Replacement Volume)

- 18 (a) [For fiscal years 2011 through 2015, the] **THE** Corps Program shall be 19 funded **EACH FISCAL YEAR** with:
- 20 (1) The amount specified in § 3–302(d) of this article; and
- 21 (2) Up to \$250,000 in additional funds that may be allocated by the 22 Trust through its annual budget process.
- 23 (b) The Trust and the Corps Board shall seek federal funds and grants and donations from private sources to be made to the Trust for the purpose of long—term funding of the Corps Program.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.
