A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Alcoholic Beverages – Queen Anne's County – Beer and Wine Festivals

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Queen Anne's County Board of License 4 Commissioners to issue a certain number of Beer and Wine Festival (BWF) $\mathbf{5}$ licenses in the county each year; authorizing the Board to select a certain 6 number of weekends each year for a certain festival; requiring the Board to 7 choose a certain location for a certain festival and to ensure that the primary 8 focus of a certain festival is the promotion of certain beer and wine; altering a 9 certain definition; making a technical correction; and generally relating to beer 10 and wine festivals in Queen Anne's County.
