A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Central Collection Unit – Monitoring and Recording of Telephone Calls**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Central Collection Unit in the Department of
4 Budget and Management to manage the monitoring and recording of certain
5 telephone calls for certain purposes; requiring monitored or recorded telephone
6 calls to contain a certain notice; and generally relating to the monitoring and
7 recording of telephone calls by the Central Collection Unit.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – State Finance and Procurement**

16 3–304.

17 **(D) (1) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF § 9–602 OF THE**
18 **CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE, AND SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS**
19 **SUBSECTION, THE CENTRAL COLLECTION UNIT MAY MANAGE THE MONITORING**
20 **AND RECORDING OF INCOMING TELEPHONE CALLS TO EMPLOYEES OF THE**
21 **CENTRAL COLLECTION UNIT TO TELEPHONES WITHIN THE OFFICES OF THE**
22 **CENTRAL COLLECTION UNIT FOR TRAINING AND QUALITY CONTROL**
23 **PURPOSES.**

1 **(2) ANY MONITORED OR RECORDED TELEPHONE CALL SHALL**
2 **CONTAIN A NOTICE TO THE TELEPHONE CALLER THAT “YOUR CALL MAY BE**
3 **RECORDED OR MONITORED FOR TRAINING AND QUALITY CONTROL PURPOSES”.**

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
5 July 1, 2013.
