## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning 2 Health - Pregnant Women - Hepatitis B Testing 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the individual attending a woman for pregnancy to submit to a medical laboratory a blood sample taken from the woman at the 4 5 time the individual first examines the woman and, under certain circumstances, 6 at the time of delivery; requiring the medical laboratory that receives the blood 7 sample to perform a certain hepatitis B test; and generally relating to the 8 testing of pregnant women for hepatitis B. 9 BY adding to 10 Article - Health - General 11 Section 18–310 Annotated Code of Maryland 12 (2009 Replacement Volume and 2012 Supplement) 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Health - General 16 17 **18–310.** THE INDIVIDUAL ATTENDING A WOMAN FOR PREGNANCY SHALL 18 (A) 19 SUBMIT TO A MEDICAL LABORATORY: 20 **(1)** A BLOOD SAMPLE TAKEN FROM THE WOMAN AT THE TIME 21THAT THE INDIVIDUAL FIRST EXAMINES THE WOMAN; AND
