BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 15 16 Article - Health - General 17 18-310. 18 (A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A WOMAN WHO OBJECTS TO A 19 STANDARD HEPATITIS B TEST BECAUSE THE TEST IS AGAINST THE RELIGIOUS 20 BELIEFS AND PRACTICES OF THE WOMAN. EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.

5 6	(2) A BLOOD SAMPLE TAKEN FROM THE WOMAN AT THE TIME OF DELIVERY IF:
7 8	(I) THE WOMAN DID NOT HAVE PRENATAL SERVICES BEFORE THE TIME OF DELIVERY; OR
9 10	(II) THERE IS NO DOCUMENTATION OF THE HEPATITIS B STATUS OF THE WOMAN.
11 12 13	(B) (C) THE MEDICAL LABORATORY RECEIVING THE BLOOD SAMPLE SUBMITTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) (B) OF THIS SECTION SHALL PERFORM A STANDARD HEPATITIS B TEST THAT IS APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
