Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

- 15 (a) The provisions of this section apply in Harford County only.
- 16 (b) (1) A licensee may sell, offer for sale, or dispense alcoholic beverages:
- 17 (i) On Monday through Sunday; and
- 18 (ii) Only between 8 a.m. and 2 a.m. the following morning.
- 19 (2) [A Class B Cafe licensee may offer to sell beer and wine:
- 20 (i) On Monday through Saturday from 10 a.m. to 11 p.m.; and
