A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Health Care Practitioners – Prescription Drug or Device Dispensing – Medical Facilities or Clinics That Specialize in Treatment Reimbursable Through Workers' Compensation Insurance

- $\mathbf{5}$ FOR the purpose of repealing a certain exception from the requirement that an 6 individual be licensed by the Board of Pharmacy before the individual may 7 practice pharmacy in the State; requiring a dentist, physician, or podiatrist who 8 dispenses a prescription drug or device in the course of treating a patient at a 9 medical facility or clinic that specializes in the treatment of medical cases reimbursable through workers' compensation insurance to obtain a dispensing 10 permit and meet certain other requirements; and generally relating to 11 12dispensing of prescription drugs or devices by dentists, physicians, or podiatrists. 13
