A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Government – Commemorative Days – Youth Political Awareness Day**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor annually to proclaim a certain day as
4 Youth Political Awareness Day; requiring that the proclamation urge certain
5 organizations to observe Youth Political Awareness Day properly; and generally
6 relating to Youth Political Awareness Day.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – State Government**

15 **13–411.**

16 **(A) THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM THE FIRST MONDAY**
17 **OF NOVEMBER AS YOUTH POLITICAL AWARENESS DAY.**

18 **(B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE CULTURAL, EDUCATIONAL,**
19 **PATRIOTIC, AND RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE YOUTH POLITICAL**
20 **AWARENESS DAY PROPERLY.**

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 October 1, 2013.
