12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – State Government

15 **13–411.**

16 (A) THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM THE FIRST MONDAY 17 OF NOVEMBER AS YOUTH POLITICAL AWARENESS DAY.

18 **(B)** THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE CULTURAL, EDUCATIONAL, 19 PATRIOTIC, AND RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE YOUTH POLITICAL 20 AWARENESS DAY PROPERLY.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 October 1, 2013.
