# Higher Education - Academic Credit for Military Education, Training, and Experience

FOR the purpose of requiring public institutions of higher education to adopt policies 4 for the purpose of awarding academic credit to a student for military education,  $\mathbf{5}$ 6 training, and experience received while an active duty member of the uniformed 7services of the United States: requiring the Marvland Higher Education 8 Commission to develop guidelines for public institutions of higher education to 9 award academic credit to certain students for military education, training, and 10 experience: requiring public institutions of higher education to utilize certain 11 guidelines to adopt policies for the awarding of certain academic credit; requiring public institutions of higher education to award academic credit to 12 certain students for military education, training, and experience beginning with 13a certain academic year: requiring the Commission to report to certain 14 committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date regarding the 15development of certain guidelines; requiring each public institution of higher 16 education to report to certain committees of the General Assembly on or before 1718 a certain date regarding the adoption of policies for the awarding of academic 19<del>credit to certain students for military education, training, and experience;</del> 20 defining certain terms; the Maryland Higher Education Commission to develop and adopt certain guidelines regarding the awarding of academic credit for 21 22military training, coursework, and education; requiring the governing bodies of each public institution of higher education to develop and implement certain 2324policies in accordance with the guidelines adopted by the Commission; and


