Vehicle Laws - Fleeing or Eluding Police

3 FOR the purpose of creating an exception to the prohibition against attempting to 4 elude a police officer under certain circumstances to allow a driver who has been 5 given a visual or an audible signal to stop by a police officer in a vehicle that is 6 not an appropriately marked police vehicle but is displaying an activated 7 flashing blue or red and blue light to proceed directly to a police station or any 8 other lighted public location before stopping; altering the law to prohibit a 9 driver who has been given a visual or an audible signal to stop by a police officer from attempting to elude the police officer in a manner that poses a risk of 10 imminent bodily injury to another person; making it a felony for a driver to 11 12 attempt, in a certain manner, to elude a police officer who gives the driver a 13 visual or an audible signal to stop and the driver's actions pose a risk of imminent bodily injury to, result in bodily injury to, or result in the death of 14 another person; defining certain terms; altering a certain definition; making 15 16 conforming changes; and generally relating to eluding police officers by drivers 17 of vehicles under certain circumstances.
