AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the compensation of the chief election judges and election judges in Calvert County during a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the compensation of the chief election judges and election judges in Calvert County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions
 of Section 2 of this Act, this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.
