- 2 (1) Meets the minimum age required under 16-103(c)(2) of this 3 subtitle;
- 4 (2) Satisfies the learner's instructional permit requirements under § 5 16–105(d)(2), (3), or (4) of this subtitle;
- 6 (3) Passes a driver skills or driver road examination administered 7 under this subtitle;
- 8 (4) Surrenders any learner's instructional permit issued to the 9 applicant; [and]
- 10 (5) SATISFIES THE FIRST AID AND CARDIOPULMONARY 11 RESUSCITATION TRAINING REQUIREMENT UNDER § 16–111.3 OF THIS 12 SUBTITLE; AND
- 13 **(6)** Pays the fee established under this subtitle.

- 15 (A) AN APPLICANT FOR A PROVISIONAL LICENSE SHALL, WITHIN 1 YEAR
- 16 OF APPLICATION, COMPLETE SUCCESSFULLY A FIRST AID AND
- 17 CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION TRAINING COURSE THROUGH THE
- 18 AMERICAN RED CROSS, THE AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION, OR A PROGRAM
- 19 WITH EQUIVALENT STANDARDS.

- 21 (1) DEVELOP AND MAKE AVAILABLE A LIST OF ORGANIZATIONS
- 22 OFFERING APPROVED FIRST AID AND CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION

- 24 (2) Prescribe a form to be used as evidence of
- 25 SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF AN APPROVED FIRST AID AND
- 26 CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION TRAINING COURSE;
- 27 (3) Provide notice in driver training materials and by
- 28 OTHER APPROPRIATE MEANS OF THE TRAINING REQUIREMENT UNDER THIS
- 29 SECTION; AND
- 30 (4) ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF
- 31 THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.
