2 (a) Before an organization listed in subsection (b) of this section may conduct 3 a gaming event, the organization shall obtain a permit from the county agency that 4 the county commissioners designate.

5 (b) An organization may conduct a gaming event for its own benefit if the 6 organization is:

7	(1)	a bona fide:	
8		(i)	religious organization;
9		(ii)	fraternal organization;
10		(iii)	civic organization;
11		(iv)	war veterans' organization;

13		(vi)	amateur athletic organization;

1 (f) (2) During each calendar year, the holder of a gaming event, including 2 a raffle for which the prize drawings are held on a single day, may not hold or receive 3 the proceeds from [:

4 (i)] more than one gaming event in which the major prize has a 5 value of more than \$5,000[; and

6 (ii) more than five raffles for which the prize drawings are held 7 on a single day and in which the major prize has a value of \$5,000 or less].

8 (4) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY REGULATE THE NUMBER 9 OF PERMITS TO CONDUCT A RAFFLE THAT AN ORGANIZATION MAY RECEIVE IN 1 10 CALENDAR YEAR.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 2013.
