12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health – General 14 20 - 115.1516 (a) (1)In this section the following words have the meanings indicated. 17(2)"Center" means any facility that produces, develops, or (i) 18 interprets: Screening MAMMOGRAMS; OR 191.

27 28 29 30 31 32	(C) IF A MAMMOGRAM OF A PATIENT DEMONSTRATES DENSE BREAST TISSUE, THE CENTER WHERE THE MAMMOGRAPHY TESTING WAS PERFORMED SHALL PROVIDE WRITTEN NOTIFICATION TO THE PATIENT THAT INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT: "YOUR MAMMOGRAM SHOWS THAT YOUR BREAST TISSUE IS DENSE. DENSE BREAST TISSUE IS VERY COMMON AND IS NOT ABNORMAL. HOWEVER, DENSE BREAST TISSUE CAN MAKE IT HARDER TO FIND		

1 CANCER ON A MAMMOGRAM AND MAY ALSO BE ASSOCIATED WITH AN 2 INCREASED RISK OF BREAST CANCER.

3 THIS INFORMATION ABOUT THE RESULT OF YOUR MAMMOGRAM IS GIVEN 4 TO YOU TO RAISE YOUR AWARENESS. USE THIS INFORMATION TO TALK TO YOUR 5 DOCTOR ABOUT YOUR OWN RISKS FOR BREAST CANCER. AT THAT TIME, ASK 6 YOUR DOCTOR IF MORE SCREENING TESTS MIGHT BE USEFUL, BASED ON YOUR 7 RISK. A REPORT OF YOUR RESULTS WAS SENT TO YOUR DOCTOR.".

8 [(c)] (D) Notwithstanding any other provision of this title, the penalty for a 9 violation of SUBSECTION (B) OF this section may not exceed \$1,000.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
October 1, 2013.
