Health Occupation Boards – Criminal History Records Checks – General Authority

FOR the purpose of authorizing a health occupation board to adopt regulations 4 5 requiring applicants for an initial license or certificate to have a criminal 6 history records check in accordance with certain provisions of this Act; 7 authorizing a health occupation board to adopt regulations requiring certain 8 applicants for reinstatement of a lapsed license or certificate, removal from 9 inactive status, or renewal of a license or certificate to have a criminal history records check in accordance with certain provisions of this Act; requiring an 10 applicant to submit certain fingerprints and fees to obtain a criminal history 11 12 records check; providing that information obtained in a criminal history records 13 check is confidential, may not be redisseminated, and may be used only for a certain purpose; authorizing certain individuals to contest certain information 14 received from a criminal history records check; defining a certain term; and 15 16 generally relating to general authority of health occupations boards to require 17 criminal history records checks.
