## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

## Crimes - Restricted Firearm Ammunition - Prohibition on Possession and Use

FOR the purpose of making it a misdemeanor to possess or use certain firearm ammunition during and in relation to the commission of a crime; establishing certain penalties; defining a certain term; and generally relating to prohibitions on the possession and use of restricted firearm ammunition.

## BY adding to

Article - Criminal Law
Section 4-110
Annotated Code of Maryland
(2012 Replacement Volume and 2012 Supplement)
SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Criminal Law

## 4-110.

(A) IN THIS SECTION, "RESTRICTED FIREARM AMMUNITION" MEANS A CARTRIDGE, A SHELL, OR ANY OTHER DEVICE THAT IS:
(1) INTENDED FOR USE IN A FIREARM; AND
(2) (I) COATED WITH OR CONTAINING, IN WHOLE OR IN PART, POLYTETRAFLUORETHYLENE OR A SIMILAR PRODUCT;

(II) COATED WITH A PLASTIC SUBSTANCE AND CONTAINING A CORE OTHER THAN LEAD OR LEAD ALLOY; OR
(III) ENTIRELY COMPOSED OF A METAL OR METAL ALLOY OTHER THAN LEAD.
(B) A PERSON MAY NOT POSSESS OR USE RESTRICTED FIREARM AMMUNITION DURING AND IN RELATION TO THE COMMISSION OF A CRIME.
(C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 5 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000 OR BOTH.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.
