- 17 (a) The clerk of each circuit court shall receive an annual salary of not more than [\$98,500] **\$114,500** as set by the Board of Public Works on the basis of the relative volume of business and receipts in the clerk's office.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the clerk of a circuit court during a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning
