3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Education to issue requests for 4 proposals for Social Impact Bonds on or before a certain date; authorizing the $\mathbf{5}$ State Board to issue additional requests for proposals as needed; establishing 6 minimum proposal guidelines; establishing minimum project selection 7 guidelines; authorizing the State Board to contract with certain entities; 8 requiring the State Board to submit reports to the Governor and the General 9 Assembly on or before a certain date each year; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the State Board of Education issuing requests for proposals 10 for Social Impact Bonds. 11

(6) ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1, 2015, AND EACH YEAR
THEREAFTER, THE STATE BOARD SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR
AND, SUBJECT TO § 2–1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE
GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE RESULTS OF THE ISSUED SOCIAL IMPACT BONDS.

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 31 July 1, 2013.

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
