A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Natural Resources – Aquaculture – Shellfish Nursery Permits

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from engaging in the commercial rearing of 4 shellfish seed outside certain leased areas without first obtaining a shellfish $\mathbf{5}$ nursery permit from the Department of Natural Resources; placing certain 6 limitations on the issuance and scope of a permit for land-based and in-water 7 shellfish nursery operations; providing that certain water quality classifications 8 and restrictions established by the Department of the Environment may not 9 affect certain in-water shellfish nursery operations; clarifying that a person is not required to obtain a water column lease or a submerged land lease for 10 in-water shellfish nursery operations; establishing a certain application process 11 and a certain application fee for permit applications; authorizing the 1213 Department of Natural Resources to deny a permit application for reasonable cause or to include conditions in a permit; establishing a certain term for a 1415permit; authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to suspend or revoke 16 a permit for certain reasons; requiring a permit holder to allow certain 17inspections by the Department of Natural Resources; authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to adopt regulations implementing this Act; 18 19defining a certain term; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally 20relating to shellfish nursery permits.

2 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "PERMIT" MEANS A SHELLFISH NURSERY PERMIT.

3 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT ENGAGE IN THE COMMERCIAL REARING OF 4 SHELLFISH SEED OUTSIDE AN AREA LEASED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE WITHOUT 5 FIRST OBTAINING A PERMIT FROM THE DEPARTMENT.

6 (C) FOR A SHELLFISH NURSERY TO BE LOCATED ON LAND, THE 7 DEPARTMENT MAY ISSUE A PERMIT ONLY TO THE OWNER OR LEGAL TENANT OF 8 THE PROPERTY OR TO A PERSON WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE PROPERTY 9 OWNER.

10 (D) (1) FOR A SHELLFISH NURSERY TO BE LOCATED IN WATERS OF 11 THE STATE OUTSIDE A LEASED AREA, THE DEPARTMENT MAY ISSUE A PERMIT 12 ONLY:

(I) TO THE OWNER OF A WHARF OR OTHER STRUCTURE
 CONSTRUCTED ON OR ABOUT THE WATER AND APPROVED BY THE U.S. ARMY
 CORPS OF ENGINEERS, OR TO A PERSON WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE OWNER
 OF THE WHARF OR OTHER STRUCTURE; AND

17 (II) FOR THE CULTIVATION OF SHELLFISH SEED WITHIN 20
18 FEET OF THE WHARF OR OTHER STRUCTURE, IN AN AREA OF WATER NOT
19 EXCEEDING 200 SQUARE FEET.

20 (2) A PERSON IS NOT REQUIRED TO OBTAIN A WATER COLUMN
 21 LEASE OR A SUBMERGED LAND LEASE FOR A PERMITTED IN–WATER SHELLFISH
 22 NURSERY OPERATION.

(3) WATER QUALITY CLASSIFICATIONS AND RESTRICTIONS
 ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT UNDER THE
 NATIONAL SHELLFISH SANITATION PROGRAM OR § 4–742 OF THIS TITLE MAY
 NOT AFFECT A PERMITTED IN–WATER SHELLFISH NURSERY OPERATION.

27 (E) (1) TO OBTAIN A PERMIT, A PERSON SHALL:

28 (I) COMPLETE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE 29 DEPARTMENT ON A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT; AND

4	(2) THE APPLICATION FEE MAY NOT EXCEED THE COST OF
5	PROCESSING THE PERMIT.
6	(F) THE DEPARTMENT MAY, AS IT CONSIDERS NECESSARY TO PROTECT
7	THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE:
8	(1) DENY A PERMIT APPLICATION FOR REASONABLE CAUSE; OR
9	(2) INCLUDE CONDITIONS IN A PERMIT.
10	(G) (1) THE TERM OF A SHELLFISH NURSERY PERMIT IS 5 YEARS.
11	(2) THE DEPARTMENT MAY REVOKE OR SUSPEND A PERMIT
12	ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION AT ANY TIME FOR NONCOMPLIANCE WITH THE
13	REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION, REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS
14	SECTION, OR THE CONDITIONS OF THE PERMIT.
15	(H) A PERMIT HOLDER SHALL ALLOW THE DEPARTMENT TO INSPECT AT
16	REASONABLE HOURS ANY FACILITIES, EQUIPMENT, OR SHELLFISH THAT ARE
17	PART OF THE PERMIT HOLDER'S SHELLFISH NURSERY OPERATIONS.
18	(I) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS
19	SECTION.
20	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
