1	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
2	MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
3	Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

5	(A) (1) In EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS
6	SUBSECTION, IN Somerset County, the Board of License Commissioners may not
7	approve any license to sell alcoholic beverages within a 300 foot measurement from
8	the nearest point of the building that is the proposed establishment for which the
9	license is requested to the nearest point of the property line of a school, church or
10	other place of worship, public library, or youth center UNLESS :
11	(1) THE OWNER OF THE PROPOSED ESTABLISHMENT FOR WHICH
12	THE LICENSE IS REQUESTED HOLDS A CURRENT LICENSE TO SELL ALCOHOLIC

14	(2) A PREVIOUS OWNER OF THE PROPOSED ESTABLISHMENT FOR
