15 Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

- (A) In Somerset County, the Board of License Commissioners may not approve any license to sell alcoholic beverages within a 300 foot measurement from the nearest point of the building that is the proposed establishment for which the license is requested to the nearest point of the property line of a school, church or
- 21 other place of worship, public library, or youth center **UNLESS**:
- 22 (1) THE OWNER OF THE PROPOSED ESTABLISHMENT FOR WHICH
- 23 THE LICENSE IS REQUESTED HOLDS A CURRENT LICENSE TO SELL ALCOHOLIC
- 24 BEVERAGES AT THE ESTABLISHMENT; OR
