## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Youth Advisory Council – Term Limit of Youth Members – Repeal**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing the term limit for the youth members of the Maryland  
4 Youth Advisory Council; and generally relating to the terms of youth members  
5 of the Maryland Youth Advisory Council.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
7 Article – State Government  
8 Section 9–2701(a)(2)  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (2009 Replacement Volume and 2012 Supplement)

11 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
12 Article – State Government  
13 Section 9–2701(e)  
14 Annotated Code of Maryland  
15 (2009 Replacement Volume and 2012 Supplement)

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – State Government**

19 9–2701.

20 (a) (2) “Council” means the Maryland Youth Advisory Council.

21 (e) (1) The term of a youth member of the Council is 1 year, from  
22 September 1 through August 30 of the following year.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1                   (2)    A youth member who is appointed or selected after a term has  
2 begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed or selected  
3 and qualifies.

4                   (3)    [A youth member may not serve more than two consecutive terms.

5                   (4)]   The member from the Senate and the member from the House  
6 serve, respectively, at the pleasure of the President of the Senate and the Speaker of  
7 the House.

8                   SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
9 October 1, 2013.
