## 1 AN ACT concerning

## Frederick Regional Higher Education Advisory Board

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Frederick Regional Higher Education Advisory 4 Board: providing for the composition, appointment, and terms of the Board 5 members; providing for the election of a chair of the Board and the 6 establishment of certain committees; prohibiting Board members from receiving 7 certain compensation but entitling Board members to reimbursement for 8 certain expenses; providing for the powers and duties of the Board; authorizing 9 the Board to apply, accept, and expend certain gifts, appropriations, or grants; 10 authorizing the Board to adopt a corporate seal; requiring the Board to keep certain records and be subject to certain audits; requiring the Frederick County 11 Chamber of Commerce Major Employers Group to take a certain action on or 12 13 before a certain date; requiring the Board to conduct a certain assessment; 14 defining certain terms; and generally relating to the establishment of the 15 Frederick Regional Higher Education Advisory Board.

- 1 (II) A MEMBER WHO IS A REPRESENTATIVE OF AN 2 OUT-OF-STATE INSTITUTION MAY NOT SERVE AS CHAIR.
- 3 (2) THE VOTING MEMBERS MAY ELECT OTHER OFFICERS AND 4 ESTABLISH COMMITTEES, INCLUDING ADVISORY COMMITTEES, AS NEEDED.
- 5 (D) IN ADDITION TO THE VOTING MEMBERS, THE FOLLOWING 6 INDIVIDUALS SHALL SERVE AS EX OFFICIO, NONVOTING MEMBERS:
- 7 (1) THE SENIOR MISSION COMMANDER OF FORT DETRICK;
- 8 (2) THE REPRESENTATIVE FROM FORT DETRICK ON THE 9 FREDERICK COUNTY BUSINESS ROUNDTABLE FOR EDUCATION EXECUTIVE 10 COMMITTEE:

- 27 (2) Assist in setting the missions of and accomplishing 28 The goals and objectives of the sites in Frederick County;

- 1 (3) Assist in establishing a Frederick Regional Higher 2 Education Center;
- 3 (4) PROVIDE GUIDANCE AND SUPPORT IN IDENTIFYING
- 4 INSTITUTIONS AND PROGRAMS TO SERVE HIGHER EDUCATION AND WORKFORCE
- 5 NEEDS IN FREDERICK COUNTY;
- 6 (5) ASSIST WITH THE MARKETING AND PROMOTION OF 7 PROGRAMS OFFERED AT THE CENTER AND SITES;
- 8 (6) FACILITATE INTERACTIONS AMONG THE BUSINESS.
- 9 NONPROFIT, EDUCATION, MILITARY, AND FREDERICK NATIONAL LABORATORY
- 10 **COMMUNITIES**;
- 11 (7) KEEP SEPARATE RECORDS AND MINUTES; AND
- 12 (8) ADOPT REASONABLE RULES, REGULATIONS, OR BYLAWS TO 13 CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- 14 (C) THE BOARD SHALL ENSURE THAT ALL ACADEMIC PROGRAMS AND
- 15 POLICIES OF THE CENTER AND SITES ARE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE POLICIES
- 16 OF AND APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION.
- 17 (D) THE BOARD MAY APPLY, ACCEPT, AND EXPEND ANY GIFT,
- 18 APPROPRIATION, OR GRANT FROM THE STATE, COUNTY, OR FEDERAL
- 19 GOVERNMENT OR ANY OTHER PERSON.
- 20 (E) THE BOARD MAY MAKE AGREEMENTS WITH THE FEDERAL, THE
- 21 STATE, OR A COUNTY GOVERNMENT OR ANY OTHER PERSON IF THE BOARD
- 22 CONSIDERS THE AGREEMENT ADVISABLE FOR THE OPERATION OF THE CENTER.
- 23 (F) THE BOARD MAY ADOPT A CORPORATE SEAL.
- 24 (G) IN ADDITION TO OTHER REPORTS THAT MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE
- 25 COMMISSION, THE BOARD SHALL:
- 26 (1) KEEP RECORDS THAT ARE CONSISTENT WITH SOUND
- 27 BUSINESS PRACTICES AND ACCOUNTING RECORDS THAT USE GENERALLY
- 28 ACCEPTED ACCOUNTING PRINCIPLES;
- 29 (2) CAUSE AN AUDIT BY AN INDEPENDENT CERTIFIED PUBLIC
- 30 ACCOUNTANT TO BE MADE OF THE ACCOUNTS AND TRANSACTIONS OF THE
- 31 CENTER AT THE CONCLUSION OF EACH FISCAL YEAR; AND

1 2 3	(3) FOR ANY STATE MONEY, BE SUBJECT TO AN AUDIT BY THE OFFICE OF LEGISLATIVE AUDITS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH §§ 2–1220 THROUGH 2–1227 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
4 5 6 7	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Frederick County Chamber of Commerce Major Employers Group shall appoint the initial members of the Frederick Regional Higher Education Advisory Board established under the provisions of this Act on or before November 1, 2013.
8 9 10	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Frederick Regional Higher Education Advisory Board shall conduct a quantitative assessment of unmet higher education needs within the Frederick region.
11 12	SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.
