That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 15 **Article - Business Regulation** 16 17-1605. 17 **(1)** IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE (A) MEANINGS INDICATED. 18 "GROCERY STORE" MEANS AN ESTABLISHMENT FOR WHICH: 19 **(2)** 20 **(I)** THE PRIMARY BUSINESS IS SELLING FOOD AT RETAIL TO

THE GENERAL PUBLIC FOR OFF-PREMISES CONSUMPTION; AND

15	(C) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT CONSUME SHARK FIN SOUP.
L6 L7	(D) A RESTAURANT, GROCERY STORE, OR INDIVIDUAL THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CIVIL PENALTIES:
18	(1) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$15,000;
19	(2) FOR A SECOND OFFENSE, A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$35,000; OR
20 21	(3) FOR A THIRD OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$50,000.
