- (A) A PERSON ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF SELLING AMMUNITION
 WHO FAILS TO MAINTAIN A RECORD OF AMMUNITION SALES OR WHO REFUSES
 TO ALLOW ACCESS TO OR INSPECTION OF RECORDS, AS REQUIRED UNDER THIS
 SUBTITLE, IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL PENALTY NOT EXCEEDING \$500 FOR EACH
 VIOLATION.
- 18 **(B)** THE CIVIL PENALTY UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE ASSESSED 19 WITH CONSIDERATION GIVEN TO:
- 20 (1) THE SERIOUSNESS OF THE VIOLATION;
- 21 (2) THE WILLFULNESS OF THE VIOLATION;
- 22 (3) THE EXTENT TO WHICH THE VIOLATION IS PART OF A 23 RECURRENT PATTERN OF THE SAME OR SIMILAR TYPE OF VIOLATION 24 COMMITTED BY THE VIOLATOR; AND
- 25 (4) ANY OTHER RELEVANT FACTORS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.
