- 14 (II) THE SHARK FIN IS TAKEN FROM A SHARK THAT THE 15 PERSON HAS TAKEN OR LANDED; AND
- 16 (III) THE SHARK FIN IS TAKEN IN A MANNER CONSISTENT 17 WITH THE PERSON'S LICENSE.
- 18 (3) A MUSEUM, COLLEGE, OR UNIVERSITY MAY POSSESS A SHARK 19 FIN IF THE SHARK FIN IS USED SOLELY FOR DISPLAY OR RESEARCH PURPOSES.
- 20 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT 21 THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.
