CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Health Occupations Boards – License Renewal, Investigation of Alleged**
3 **Violations, and Immunity from Liability**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing certain health occupations boards within the
5 Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to establish a certain electronic
6 system for the purpose of distributing certain licenses, permits, certifications, or
7 registrations; requiring the system to meet certain requirements; requiring
8 certain boards to discontinue sending by first-class mail certain renewal notices
9 and a renewed license, permit, certificate, or registration, subject to a certain
10 exception; requiring certain boards to send by electronic means certain renewal
11 notices and a renewed license, permit, certification, or registration; requiring
12 certain boards to continue to send by first-class mail an initial license, permit,
13 certification, or registration; requiring certain health occupations boards to
14 investigate certain violations of law; providing immunity from liability for
15 certain persons who provide certain information to certain health occupations
16 boards or participate in certain activities; authorizing certain health
17 occupations boards to send a certain notice by electronic means or first-class
18 mail; providing that certain individuals who act in good faith and within the
19 scope of jurisdiction of certain boards are not civilly liable for providing certain
20 information or for participating in certain activities; defining certain terms;
21 altering certain definitions; making certain conforming and stylistic changes;
22 and generally relating to the health occupations boards and license renewal,
23 investigation of alleged violations, and immunity from liability.

33 **ELECTRONIC SYSTEM FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF A RENEWED LICENSE, PERMIT,**
34 **CERTIFICATION, OR REGISTRATION REQUIRED TO BE ISSUED UNDER THIS**
35 **TITLE.**

3 **ELECTRONIC OR PHYSICAL** address provided by the licensee and advise the licensee
4 of:

5 (1) The date on which the current license expires;

6 (2) The date by which the renewal application must be received by the
7 Board for the renewal to be issued and mailed before the license expires; and

8 (3) The amount of the renewal fee.

10 (a) A license expires on the date set by the Board, unless the license is
11 renewed for an additional term as provided in this section. A license may not be
12 renewed for a term of longer than 2 years.

22 (a) (1) A license or registration expires on the date set by the Board,
23 unless the license or registration is renewed for a 1-year term as provided in this

4 certification, monitoring of, and enforcement requirements for a dental radiation
5 technologist; and

6 (3) Provide for a requirement to ensure competency in new safety and
7 technological advances.

2 licensee, by **ELECTRONIC MEANS OR** first-class mail to the last known **ELECTRONIC**
3 **OR PHYSICAL** address of the licensee, a renewal notice that states:

4 (1) The date on which the current license expires;

5 (2) The date by which the renewal application must be received by the
6 Board for the renewal to be issued and mailed before the license expires; and

7 (3) The amount of the renewal fee.

9 (a) A license expires on the second anniversary of its effective date, unless
10 the license is renewed for a 2-year term as provided in this section.
