## State Brain Injury Trust Fund

FOR the purpose of establishing the State Brain Injury Trust Fund as a special fund to be used to support certain services for certain individuals with brain injuries; requiring the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene or the Secretary's designee to administer the Fund; requiring the Secretary or the Secretary's designee to report to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date each year; establishing eligibility for individuals to receive assistance from the Fund; requiring that certain investment earnings be credited to the Fund; altering the amount of a certain motor vehicle registration fee surcharge; requiring that a certain amount of the motor vehicle registration fee surcharge be paid into the Fund; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the establishment of the State Brain Injury Trust Fund.
