13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

paragraph (2) of this subsection for Baltimore County, in paragraph (3) of this

City, [and] in paragraph (5) of this subsection for Harford County, AND IN
PARAGRAPH (6) OF THIS SUBSECTION FOR CARROLL COUNTY, the clerk of each
circuit court shall:

(i) Collect, in advance, a \$10 fee for docketing the appearance of
 counsel when bringing or defending a civil action in the court;
