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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Safety – Regulated Firearm License – Reciprocity**

3 FOR the purpose of specifying that a license issued by another state to an individual  
4 authorizing the individual to carry a regulated firearm, including a concealed  
5 regulated firearm, is valid in Maryland; and generally relating to regulated  
6 firearms.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
8 Article – Public Safety  
9 Section 5–101(p)  
10 Annotated Code of Maryland  
11 (2011 Replacement Volume and 2012 Supplement)

12 BY adding to  
13 Article – Public Safety  
14 Section 5–117.1  
15 Annotated Code of Maryland

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Public Safety**

20 5–101.

21 (p) “Regulated firearm” means:

22 (1) a handgun; or

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
7 October 1, 2013.
