CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

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## Employees' Pension System – Elected or Appointed Officials – <del>Optional</del> Membership

FOR the purpose of providing that certain elected or appointed officials whose employers are participating employers of the State Retirement and Pension System may elect to join the Employees' Pension System within a certain period of time: providing that certain elected or appointed officials whose employers are participating employers of the State Retirement and Pension System may elect to cease membership in the Employees' Pension System within a certain period of time; requiring certain elected or appointed officials who make an election to join or an election to cease membership to complete a certain form and file it with the Board of Trustees for the State Retirement and Pension System: providing that certain elected or appointed officials who do not make an election to join within a certain period of time may not join the Employees' Pension System; providing that certain elected or appointed officials who do not make an election to cease membership within a certain period of time remain members in the Employees' Pension System; requiring the Board of Trustees to adopt certain regulations; defining a certain term; prohibiting certain individuals who are serving in certain elected or appointed positions from being members of the Employees' Pension System while serving in those positions; and generally relating to entional membership for elected or appointed officials in the Employees' Pension System.
