1 (V) (1) A CUSTODIAN SHALL DENY INSPECTION OF ANY RECORD 2 WHICH INDICATES THAT A PERSON OWNS A FIREARM, AS DEFINED IN § 5–101 OF 3 THE PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE, INCLUDING A RECORD OF A HANDGUN PERMIT 4 ISSUED UNDER § 5–306 OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE OR OF A HANDGUN 5 PERMIT APPLICATION MADE UNDER § 5–304 OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE.

6 (2) A CUSTODIAN SHALL PERMIT INSPECTION OF THE RECORDS 7 SPECIFIED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION BY THE PERSON WHO IS THE 8 SUBJECT OF THE RECORD.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 10 October 1, 2013.
