- 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 15–106.4(d) of Article – Education of the Annotated 3 Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 15–106.4(e). SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland 4 read as follows: 5 6 Article - Education 7 15-106.4. 8 [This] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION.
