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## Maryland Highway Safety Act of 2013

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the issuance, to new applicants, of identification 4 cards, moped operators' permits, and drivers' licenses that are not acceptable by 5 federal agencies for certain official purposes; requiring a certain applicant for an 6 identification card, a moped operator's permit, or a driver's license to provide 7 certain evidence that the applicant has filed certain Maryland income tax returns or has resided in Maryland for a certain period of time and been claimed 8 9 as a dependent on certain Maryland income tax returns; repealing a provision of law that prohibits, after a certain date, the issuance or renewal of identification 10 cards, moped operators' permits, and drivers' licenses that are not acceptable by 11 12 federal agencies for certain official purposes; requiring that certain identification cards, moped operators' permits, and drivers' licenses include a 13 certain statement; repealing a requirement that certain identification cards, 14 moped operators' permits, and drivers' licenses that are not acceptable by 15 16 federal agencies for certain official purposes expire by a certain date; providing 17 for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to the issuance of 18 identification cards, moped operators' permits, and drivers' licenses that are not 19 acceptable by federal agencies for certain official purposes.
