Calvert County – Alcoholic Beverages – Special Event Licenses

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Calvert County Board of License Commissioners 4 to issue a Special Event (SE) license; authorizing the Board to issue a Special $\mathbf{5}$ Event license to certain persons; establishing that a holder of a Special Event 6 license may sell at retail beer, wine, and liquor for consumption in a certain 7 location and in certain areas on certain property during the special event; 8 establishing certain fees; establishing that this Act may not prohibit a licensee 9 from holding another alcoholic beverages license; requiring the Board to determine the number of licenses an applicant may apply for in a given year; 10 authorizing the Board to approve certain conditions for issuance of a Special 11 12Event license; authorizing the Board to adopt certain regulations; defining 13 certain terms; and generally relating to the issuance of a Special Event license 14in Calvert County.

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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1 (2) "BOARD" MEANS THE CALVERT COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE 2 COMMISSIONERS.

(3) "SPECIAL EVENT" MEANS AN EVENT THAT IS ATTENDED BY
THE PUBLIC FOR A SPECIAL OR PARTICULAR PURPOSE, INCLUDING A CONCERT,
A FUNDRAISING EVENT FOR A CHARITABLE OR NOT-FOR-PROFIT CAUSE, A
HOLIDAY EVENT, A PARTY, A SEASONAL LOCAL BUSINESS OPENING OR CLOSING,
A BALL, A GALA, A FESTIVAL, AND ANY OTHER DISTINCTIVE, TRADITIONAL, OR
UNIQUE EVENT FOR WHICH A SPECIAL ONE-DAY TEMPORARY LICENSE IS NOT
APPLICABLE.

10 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN CALVERT COUNTY.

11 (C) THERE IS A SPECIAL EVENT (SE) LICENSE.

(D) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A SPECIAL EVENT LICENSE TO A PERSON
 REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE PERSON ALREADY HOLDS A RETAIL ALCOHOLIC
 BEVERAGES LICENSE.

15 (E) (1) A SPECIAL EVENT LICENSE ENTITLES THE HOLDER TO SELL 16 AT RETAIL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE LICENSED 17 PREMISES, INCLUDING PATRON AREAS, PARKING LOTS, AND OTHER AREAS OF 18 THE PROPERTY THAT ARE TO BE USED FOR THE SPECIAL EVENT DURING THE 19 HOURS DESIGNATED FOR THE EVENT.

20(2)THE SPECIAL EVENT LICENSE IS VALID ONLY FOR THE EVENT21SPECIFIED ON THE SPECIAL EVENT LICENSE APPLICATION.

22 (F) (1) IF THE SPECIAL EVENT IS HELD FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES, 23 THE FEE FOR THE SPECIAL EVENT LICENSE IS \$100.

(2) IF THE SPECIAL EVENT IS HELD FOR CHARITABLE OR
NOT-FOR-PROFIT PURPOSES, THE FEE FOR THE SPECIAL EVENT LICENSE IS
\$10.

27(G)THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT THE LICENSEE FROM HOLDING28ANOTHER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE OF A DIFFERENT CLASS OR29NATURE.

30(H) THE BOARD SHALL DETERMINE THE NUMBER OF LICENSES AN31APPLICANT MAY BE ISSUED IN A GIVEN YEAR.

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1 **(I)** AFTER A PRESENTATION BY THE APPLICANT, THE BOARD MAY $\mathbf{2}$ **APPROVE:** 3 (1) THE LOCATION FOR THE SPECIAL EVENT PROPOSED IN THE 4 **APPLICATION;** $\mathbf{5}$ (2) THE AREA ON THE PROPERTY FOR THE SALE AND 6 CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL FOR THE SPECIAL EVENT PROPOSED IN THE 7 **APPLICATION;** 8 THE PERIOD OF TIME DURING WHICH: (3) 9 **(I)** THE SPECIAL EVENT PROPOSED IN THE APPLICATION 10 MAY BE HELD; AND 11 **(II)** THE SPECIAL EVENT LICENSE IS VALID; 12(4) IF REQUESTED IN THE APPLICATION FOR THE LICENSE, THE 13 NUMBER, LOCATION, AND TYPES OF ADDITIONAL BARS, PORTABLE CARTS, OR OTHER TYPES OF PORTABLE OR PERMANENT SERVICE STRUCTURES FOR THE 1415SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT THE SPECIAL EVENT; 16 (5) ANY SECURITY OR OTHER SAFETY MEASURES FOR THE 17PROTECTION OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE; AND 18 (6) ANY OTHER REASONABLE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ISSUANCE 19 OF A SPECIAL EVENT LICENSE. 20**(J)** THE BOARD MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS 21SECTION. 22SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23July 1, 2013.
