Hunting – Schools – Expanded Safety Zone

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person, while hunting for any wild bird or mammal, from shooting or discharging any firearm or other deadly weapon within a certain distance of a public or nonpublic school; and generally relating to hunting safety zones.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 (g) (1) Except as provided in [paragraph (2)] PARAGRAPHS (2) AND (3)
 17 of this subsection, a person, other than the owner or occupant, while hunting for any
 18 wild bird or mammal may not shoot or discharge any firearm or other deadly weapon
 19 within 150 yards, known as the "safety zone," of a dwelling house, residence, church,
 20 or other building or camp occupied by human beings, or shoot at any wild bird or
 21 mammal while it is within this area, without the specific advance permission of the
 22 owner or occupant.

- [(2)] (3) For archery hunters in Carroll County or Frederick County, the safety zone described in paragraph (1) of this subsection extends for 50 yards from a dwelling house, residence, church, or any other building or camp occupied by human beings.
- **[**(3)**] (4)** During any open hunting season, a person, other than the owner or occupant, may not hunt or chase willfully any wild bird or mammal within the safety zone without the specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.
